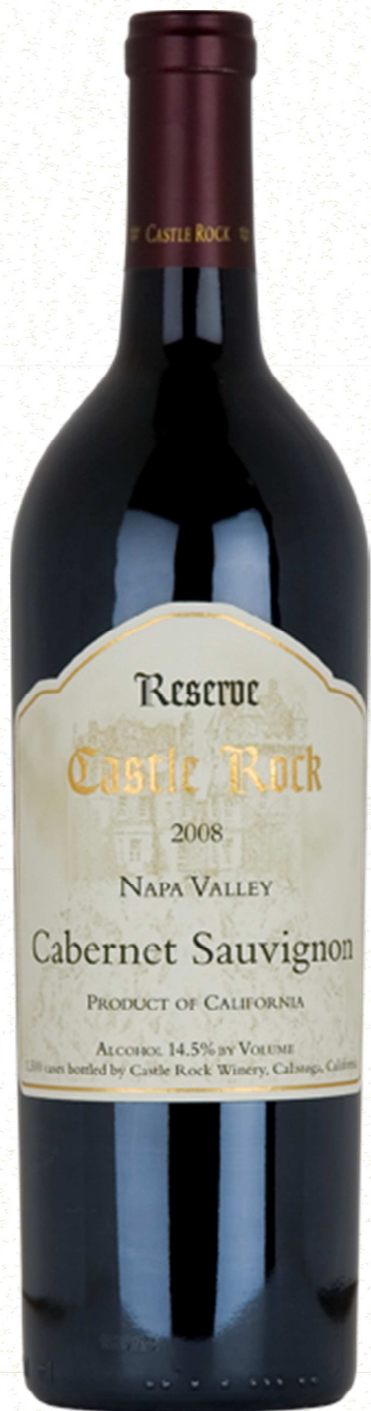

2008 RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON NAPA VALLEY

WE CAREFULLY HANDCRAFTED ONLY 1,300 CASES OF THE 2008 CASTLE ROCK RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON. THE GRAPES WERE HARVESTED FROM VINES GROWN IN THE NAPA VALLEY, ONE OF CALIFORNIA'S MOST PRESTIGIOUS GRAPE GROWING APPELLATIONS. THE WINE WAS FERMENTED AND THEN AGED FOR EIGHTEEN MONTHS IN MAINLY NEW FRENCH OAK BARRELS.

OUR CASTLE ROCK RESERVE CABERNET SAUVIGNON IS A DELICIOUSLY FULL WINE LOADED WITH NUANCE AND FLAVOR. IT IS A DEEP GARNET IN COLOR, AND HAS AROMAS OF DARK CHERRY AND MOLASSES. ON THE PALATE IT GIVES DARK FRUIT FLAVORS WITH A HINT OF CEDAR. THE TANNINS ARE MELLOW, AND IT FINISHES HARMONIOUSLY WITH LONG-LASTING FRUIT FLAVORS. IT IS PERFECT FOR DRINKING NOW, OR IT CAN BE ALLOWED TO AGE AND IMPROVE THROUGH 2013.
