OUR 2008 CASTLE ROCK PINOT NOIR IS PRODUCED FROM GRAPES FROM A CAREFULLY SELECTED GROUP OF VINEYARDS IN CALIFORNIA'S PRESTIGIOUS NAPA COUNTY. THESE VINEYARDS PROVIDE EXCELLENT GROWING CONDITIONS FOR THIS DELICATE BURGUNDIAN VARIETAL.

THE WINE IS ELEGANT AND MEDIUM-BODIED, OFFERING LAYERS OF BLACK CHERRY, SWEET VANILLA OAK, SPICE, CINNAMON AND FLORAL NOTES. ON THE PALATE IT IS SMOOTH WITH SILKY TEXTURES, MILD TANNINS AND A LONG HARMONIOUS FINISH. THIS VERSATILE FOOD WINE PAIRS WELL WITH LAMB, VEAL, SALMON AND LIGHT PASTA DISHES.
